DAILY FEEDING GUIDE

Seminole Cat Food is formulated for all life stages. The following table should be used as a guide since cats vary widely in their food requirements. See below recommendations for pregnant and lactating females, weaning kittens and growing kittens.

BODY WEIGHT (lbs.)	CUPS per DAY (Standard Measuring)
3 - 5	1/5 to 1/3
5 - 10	1/3 to 1/2
10 - 15	1/2 to 2/3
15 - 20	2/3 to 1

RECOMMENDATIONS

These suggested feeding directions are guidelines only. The amount to feed each day may need to be adjusted upward or downward depending on age, activity, temperament and environment, to maintain normal body condition. Cats should not be allowed to become overweight.

Pregnant & Lactating Females - During pregnancy, feed the amount needed to maintain good body condition. Food intake may double during late pregnancy. During lactation, feed the amount needed to maintain adequate milk production for the kittens, which may be 2-4 times the amount indicated in the feeding table for daily food consumption.

Weaning Kittens - Start feeding kittens as early as they begin to nibble at solid foods, usually at 3-4 weeks of age. Mix dry food with water to soften and offer only the amount the kittens will consume within 1-2 hours. Remove the wet food after 2 hours and clean feeding bowls. Kittens at this age can be fed 4-6 times per day. Overfeeding may result in loose stools.

Growing Kittens - At 6-8 weeks of age, kittens can usually be fed at will. If water is used to moisten the food, change feed and clean feeding bowls frequently to ensure freshness. Overfeeding may result in loose stools.

Adult Cats - May eat several small meals per day. Some cats can be fed at will, while other cats tend to overeat and must be restricted to 2-4 meals per day, depending on activity level. Adjust feeding level to maintain normal body condition.

ALWAYS HAVE FRESH CLEAN WATER AVAILABLE.

We recommend your pets visit a veterinarian on a regular basis.

Make all feeding changes gradually over a 7-10 day period to minimize intestinal upset.
